- Your digital solo should be no more than 8mins and for a specific digital platform such as Instagram, zoom, facebook, youtube, a podcast or other.
- Your digital solo can be live or pre-recorded.
- Please note you'll be responsible for the technical aspect of your commission. You can collaborate with other creatives, but bear in mind we will not be able to offer more than £100.
- During the creative process, you'll have 2 mentoring sessions with Footprint's A.D. and solo artist <u>Gaël Le Cornec</u> and one digital technology session with Ben Samuels from mixed-reality company <u>Limbik Theatre</u>.
- The final commission will be released online in September on Footprint Productions website and all their social media platforms.
- Successful applicants must be UK residents.
